Dear Parent/Guardian(s):

It will soon be that time of year when our middle school students begin planning for the annual Middle School Farewell dance that will be held on Friday, June 1, 2018 from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. here in the middle school. All tickets must be purchased in advance and will go on sale during lunches prior to the dance. Listen for announcements on DNN closer to the Farewell Dance. Students **MUST** be in good academic standing to purchase tickets.

This event has been a wonderful tradition for us here at Northern Lehigh. It is a time for all of our students to reminisce about their year and to enjoy an evening of fun while wearing some of their finer attire.

The recommended apparel is a nice dress or skirt for the girls and a shirt and tie for the boys. **This is NOT a formal or semi-formal dance.** Our students will have opportunities for wearing tuxedos and evening gowns as they move through their high school years. We do not encourage the wearing of these types of garments for this dance. We want every one of our students to be able to attend the Farewell without feeling less than adequate in his or her attire. Although after the normal school day, dress-code rules still apply. Anyone not within dress-code, or the ability to comply, may be turned away at the door.

This will be the last middle school social affair for our eighth graders. Therefore, eighth graders only will once again have the opportunity to invite one student guest who is not a Northern Lehigh Middle School student. He or she will be required to register the guest several weeks before the dance. Guests must be 15 years old or younger, in middle school or high school. More information is on the Dance registration form, which can be obtained in the middle school office and is due back by May 25, 2018. Final approval for the guest's attendance will be determined by the building administration.
