206. ASSIGNMENT WITHIN DISTRICT	
1. Purpose SC 1310	The Board directs that the assignment of students to schools within this district be consistent with proper education of students and the best use of the resources of this district.
2. Authority	<p>It shall be the policy of the Board to establish an attendance area for each elementary school in the School District.</p> <p>All children attending school in the School District shall attend the school defined by the attendance boundaries for the area in which they live. Exceptions to the above stated policy may be initiated or granted by the administration when accumulated information or the considered judgment of the administration clearly indicates that the exception would be in the best interest of the individual student.</p>
3. Delegation of Responsibility	<p>The Board authorizes the Superintendent to grant or deny requests for individuals to attend school other than the one in the established attendance area if the student(s) meets the following criteria:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The change appears to be in the best interests of the individual. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Written documentation of the change will be recorded. 2. When enrollment becomes greatly imbalanced in certain elementary grades throughout the district, the Superintendent may reassign selected students from their neighborhood schools to another school to bring about a more equal teacher/pupil ratio. 3. No bus route will be extended beyond its normal run. Criteria number two (2) excepted. 4. Principal/elementary supervisor of both schools involved approve the change. 5. The Superintendent finds the change to be in the best interests of the district.
