PROVISIONAL CONTRACTING STATEMENT**

(under ACT 114 of 2006)

Effective July 1, 2009 for newly registered officials, officials registered since April 1, 2007, and officials whose registration has lapsed for more than one year.

I, hereby affirm that:

(1) I have applied for the criminal history background checks (PA State Police and FBI) and child abuse history (DPW) required under Act 114 and will provide copies of the appropriate completed request forms to the school;

(2) Nothing found in the results will disqualify me from working in direct contact with children, pursuant to Act 114;

(3) I understand that I am being permitted to work on a provisional basis pending receipt of the above clearance and any inaccurate, false or incorrect statements shall be grounds for immediate discontinuance of my services.

(4) I understand that I am not to work alone with children and will work in the immediate vicinity of a permanent employee until such clearance is received and on file with the school;

(5) I have not been convicted of or plead nolo contendere to any of the following offenses within five years immediately preceding the date of my report of criminal history information:

(a) An offense under one or more of the following provisions of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes:
