- 2. All students are expected to take their exams during the time the exam is scheduled (see End of Second Semester Calendar).
- 3. If a student is **exempt** (**SENIORS ONLY**) from a block 1 or block 3 exam, he/she may come in just for the second or fourth block exam with a note from a parent. Bring your note that day and sign-in at the Main Office. If a student is **exempt** (**SENIORS ONLY**) from an block 2 or 4 exam, he/she may leave after the first or third exam with a note from a parent. Bring your note that day and sign-out in the Main Office.
